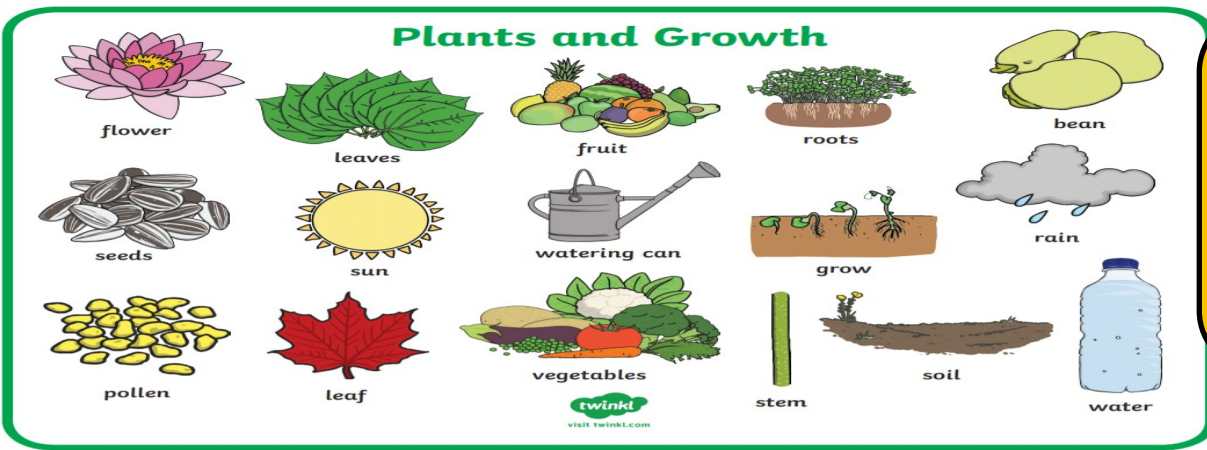

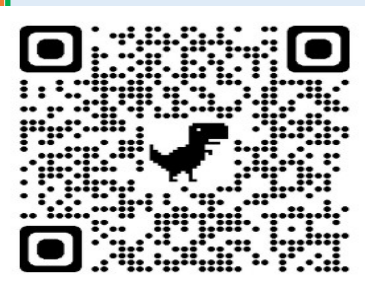

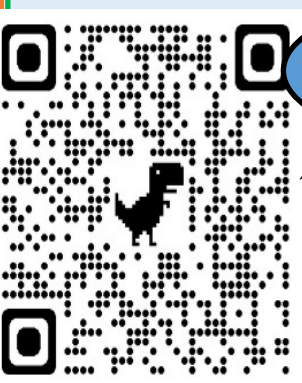
Plants-Seasonal Changes

Plants provide food for people and animals to eat.

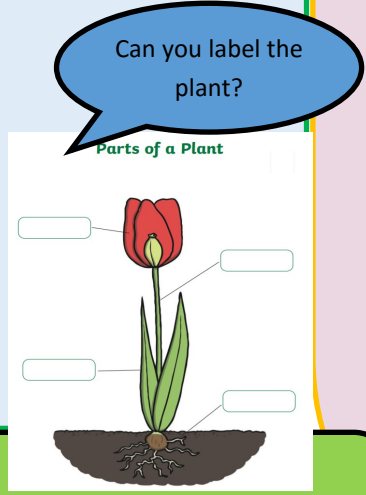
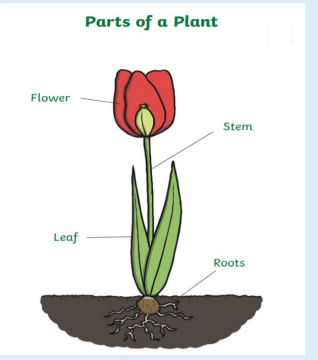

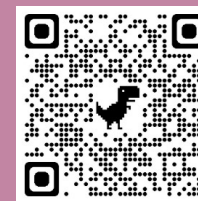


Geography

Human features are houses, roads and bridges are things that have been built by people.



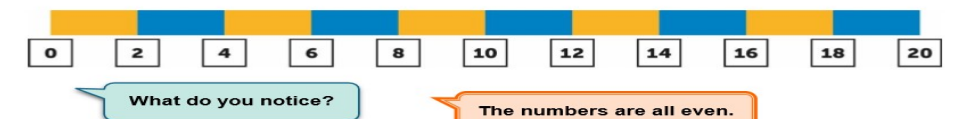
