



Here are the features of a non-fiction text.

Key word	Meaning
Glossary	A glossary is like a dictionary. It explains what key words from the text mean.
Heading	The main title of the text.
Sub-heading	Mini titles throughout the text which tell you what a section is about.
Label	Words which help you identify a picture and its parts.
Contents Page	A page at the front of the book that lists the titles and chapters.
Diagram	Drawings throughout the book.
