Science-Animals

There are lots of animal groups in our world.
How many animals groups can you name?

Amphibians

Are **cold** blooded.
Live on land and water.
Have moist skin and webbed feet.
Have skeletons on the inside of their bodies.
Lay eggs.

Birds

Are **warm** blooded.
Live on land and water.
Have feathers (unique to birds), wings and a beak.
Have skeletons on the inside of their bodies.
Lay eggs.

Fish

Are **cold** blooded.
Live in water.
Have fins to move and gills to breathe under water.
Have skeletons on the inside of their bodies.
Lay eggs (in water).

Mammals

Are **warm** blooded.
Live on land and in water.
Have hair or fur.
Have skeletons on the inside of their bodies.
Give birth to live babies which drink their mother's milk.

Reptiles

Are **cold** blooded.
Live on land and in water.
Have scales, ear holes and dry skin.
Have skeletons on the inside of their bodies (but tortoises have one on the outside, too).
Lay eggs.

Herbivores

These are animals that only like to eat plants.

Examples:
•Cows
•Horses
•Sheep
•Elephants
•Deer

Omnivores

These are animals that like to eat plants and meat.

Examples:
•Humans
•Bears
•Monkeys
•Seagulls

Carnivores

These are animals that mainly like to eat meat.

Examples:
•Lions
•Cats
•Sharks
•Snakes
•Wolves
