Science:

Living things and their habitats.

We will be learning about the habitats of the world.

What can you find out about: the desert, ocean, woodland, grassland and tundra habitat.

Habitat A place that an animal lives. A habitat provides food, water and shelter for survival.

Microhabitat A small-scale habitat found inside an environment (e.g. under a log)

Minibeast A small invertebrate animal such as an insect or spider

Species A group of animals, plants or other living things that share common characteristics and that are classified as similar.

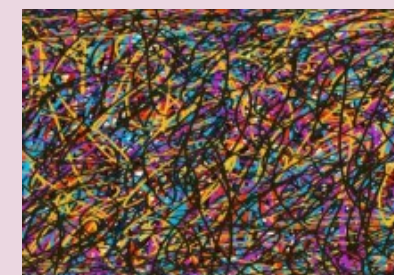
Pulse The 'heartbeat' of the song

In PE we are learning

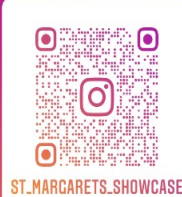
Dance and fundamentals.

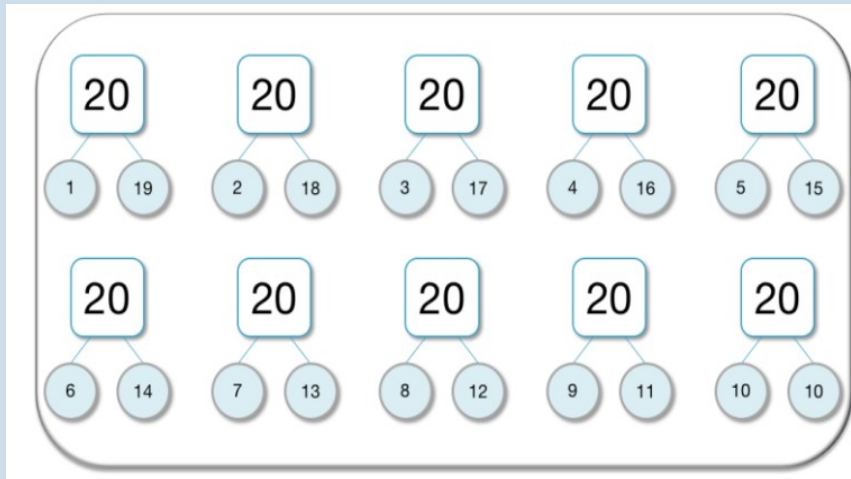

Number bonds are pairs of numbers that make up a given number. Try to learn the number bonds to 20.

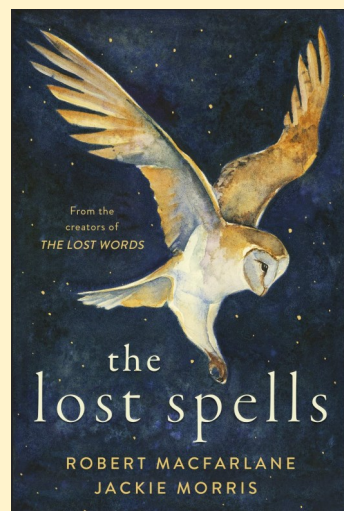
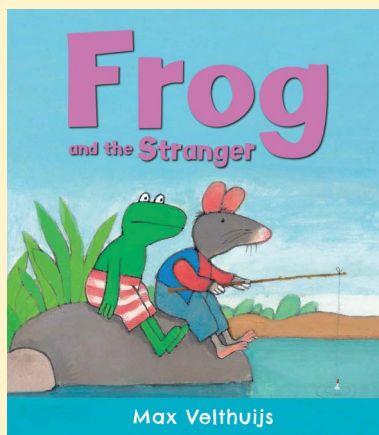


English

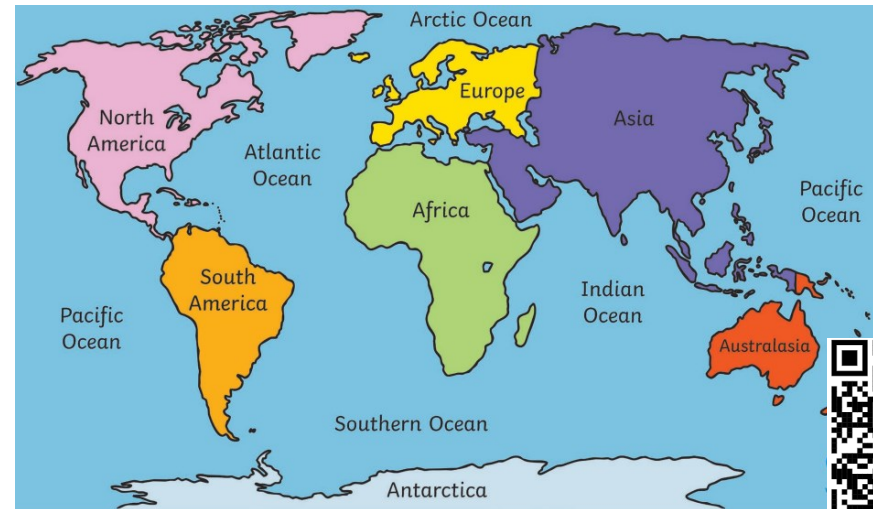
In Year 2, we will be exploring sentence structure and using the conjunction **and** in our sentences to extend our writing.

The measurement of how hot or cold a place is. Temperature is measured in degrees Celsius (°C).
