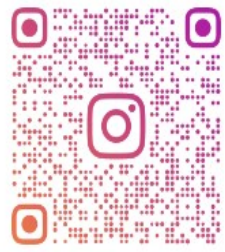

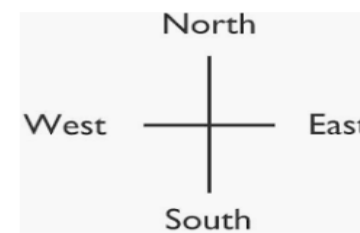
PSHE : Emotional wellbeing

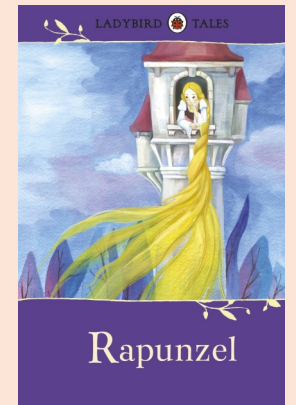
P.E
