
## **English**


We will be starting this term by reading Real-Life Mysteries which will inspire us to write our own newspaper reports.

We need to focus on using fronted adverbials to make our writing interesting and informative.















### **Class Novel**

We are reading Jamila Gavin's Blackberry Blue: And Other Fairy Tales. A collection of six enchanting fairy tales for us to get lost in!




### **Maths**






#### **Science**

#### **Living Things And Their Habitats**

Plants and animals rely on their environment to give them everything they need. Therefore, when habitats change, it can be very dangerous to the plants and animals that live there. Changes to an environment can be natural or caused by humans.

Natural: earthquakes, storms, floods. Draughts, wildfires, the seasons.



Human-made: deforestation, pollution, urbanisation, the introduction of a new animal or plant species to an environment.

## **History**

### **London Olympics**

The first Olympic Games was held in 776 BC.

London became the first city to host the modern Olympic Games three times.



London also hosted the <u>1908 Summer Olympics</u>, <u>1948 Summer Olympics</u> and the 2012 Summer Olympics.

Nine cities had submitted bids to host the 2012 Olympics. These cities were <u>Havana</u>, <u>Istanbul</u>, <u>Leipzig</u>, <u>London</u>, <u>Madrid</u>, <u>Moscow</u>, <u>New York</u>, <u>Paris</u>, and <u>Rio de Janeiro</u>.

Athletes from 204 National Olympic Countries took part in the 2012 London Olympics.

The 2012 Summer Olympics event had 26 sports.

The Olympic games happen every 4 years.
