Co-ordinates

Read co-ordinates along the x axis (horizontal) first, then the y axis (vertical). E.g. (3,-4) = go right 3, down 4.

PSHE - Keeping Safe

After learning about Online Safety, Keeping Safe considers safety in the real world beginning with the four types of abuse: sexual, physical, emotional and neglect. Children will learn how to spot each type of abuse and who they can go to for help. Children will also learn more about practices against British law and how forced marriage is not compatible with God's plan for marriage. The final three sessions in this module explore how drugs, alcohol and tobacco can negatively affect people's lifestyles and the body's natural functioning, discuss how to make good choices even in pressured situations, and teach essential First Aid such as DR ABC and the recovery position.

The mean

The mean is a type of average. To find the mean, add up all the numbers and divide by how many there are. E.g. the mean of 4, 5, 3, 4 is 4. (Because 4 + 5 +3 + 4 = 16, and $16 \div 4 = 4$)

Using colons: and semi-colons;

Colons:

They can be used to introduce information.

We have three flavours of ice-cream: vanilla, chocolate or strawberry.

A colon can also separate a sentence into two independent clauses when the two clauses are directly related and you mean to emphasise the second clause.

The roads are icy: it's dangerous to drive today.

Semi-colons;

Just like colons, semi-colons can be used to separate two independent clauses that are related.

The roads are icy; it's dangerous to drive today. Semi-colons can also be used to separate items in a list, if each item is longer than one word.

Mexico

Mexico is a country in North America.

It has a coast on two sides; the Pacific Ocean on the west, and the Gulf of Mexico and Caribbean Sea in the east.

Much of Mexico is covered by mountains, and the highest peaks are over 5,000 metres. The north of the country is dominated by deserts, and these regions receive so little rain that only a few specially adapted plants and animals can survive.

In the centre lies its sprawling capital Mexico City.

The south of Mexico is close to the equator so it has a tropical climate, and covered by vast rainforests with a huge diversity of plants and animals.

We use scientific symbols to represent components (parts) of a circuit.

The brightness of a bulb or the loudness of a buzzer is affected by the number of cells in a circuit.

The brightness of a bulb or the loudness of a buzzer is affected by the voltage of cells in a circuit.

The number of components in a circuit can affect how they function.

The arrangement of components in a circuit can affect how they function.

The length of wires in a circuit can affect how the components function.
