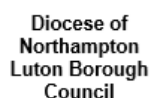

ADVENT TERM

Pupils will be learning:

CREATED AND LOVED BY GOD

Religious Understanding

Pupils hear the story of creation, where God created the earth, sea, stars, plants, animals and humans. The five-story sessions encourage pupils to creatively explore this topic and help them to deeply know that they are created by God out of love and for love.

Suggested activities for home:

Take a walk outside with your child and notice the different things that God has created.

LENT TERM

Pupils will be learning:

CREATED TO LOVE OTHERS

Religious Understanding

This unit helps pupils to understand why the Bible is so special to Christians, and secondly helps pupils to act out the Gospel account of Jesus washing His disciples' feet, showing that He loves us and is a role model for us to copy in loving one another.

Key Vocabulary:

Bible story God's family Jesus role model example love sharing caring being kind please thank you helping

Suggested activities for home:

In this unit pupils are challenged to follow in the footsteps of Jesus by showing His love to those around them. Praise them when they are kind and caring at home, and perhaps pray together, thanking God for His love and asking for His help to live like Jesus.

PENTECOST TERM

Pupils will be learning:

CREATED TO LIVE IN COMMUNITY

Religious Understanding

This unit introduces in a very simple way the concept of the Trinity, where God is three-in-one and each part loves the others and loves us. Pupils will come to understand that as we are made in the image of God, we are designed to love God and love one another in our wider communities too. Through the story of Jesus feeding the 5000 with just the humble offering of a small boy, pupils will learn that our loving actions can be used by God to do incredible things.

Suggested activities for home:

In this session, pupils were challenged to fill a 'Caring Cross' with acts of love (colouring in squares when caring or loving actions were identified by an adult). You might like to make one of these at home for the whole family – not for use as a reward chart, but as a way to celebrate acts of love within your household.
