Thank you to parents and carers that have this week engaged with their children and supported them with their reading at home. We have had lots of children reading at home and then coming in to school to complete quizzes. Remember children should read at home for 15 – 20 minutes a day. As we all know reading is so important and we want to support our children to become the best readers they can. This term we have spent nearly **£4,000.00** on new books to engage our children.











Accelerated Reader is a computer programme that helps teachers manage and monitor a child's independent reading practice. Children pick a book that falls within their level. When they have finished reading, they take a short quiz on a computer **at school** - passing the quiz is an indication that the child has understood what has been read. If they are reading at the recommended level for them, then most children are likely to be successful and enjoy the books and quizzes. Best of all they learn and grow at their own pace.

Please support your child at home by:

- Reading with your child for at least 15 minutes a day.
- Making sure your child brings their reading book to school every day.
- Record in your child's reading record when they have read with you at home.
- Support your child to look after school reading books. (Damaged and lost reading books will need to be paid for by parents).

More information will be shared with you as the children and staff get used to Accelerated Reader, but the main thing for now is please **support your child to read every day!**
